Leader Tip for Session 2: Looking Back; Cherish or Cling?

Carol, the leader from Highlands Church in Scottsdale, AZ, gives each woman a tea bag with this poem on the back:

Since we cannot sit and chat the way we used to do, just brew a cup of tea and I will make one too. And as we share our tea together, though distance separates us still, we'll call to mind the fun we had and then our hearts will fill.



The idea is to send the tea bag to a friend she left behind. She can't send it 'back home' because HOME is where she is living NOW. This can encourage the women in your study to gently let go of friends, family, and things in the past while clinging to God for what lies ahead.


